

## SEMINAR TO GUIDE INVESTORS LOOKING TO DO BUSINESS IN USA

FIEO organized seminar on 'Establishing Business in USA and Business Immigration: Opportunities & Challenges under Trump Administration' on February 26, 2019 at Ahmedabad in Gujarat.

Mr Jayprakash Goel, Head, FIEO (Gujarat Chapter) welcomed the participants and said economic, professional and industrial opportunities that USA provides are far better than those in any other country in the world. establishing subsidiary in USA which helped his business grow in the country.

Mr David Nachman and Ms Snehal Batra, managing attorneys of NPZ Law Group, USA made a joint presentation on the subject at the seminar. They said: "USA welcomes foreign investment and encourages people doing business in the country. Investors can seek EB-5 Visa in two ways – either by directly investing a sum of USD one

million or by investing USD 5,00,000 in the targeted employment area with creation of employment for 10 full time workers or through Regional Investment Centres that are involved in promotion of economic growth, improved regional productivity, job creation and increased domestic capital investment. Approval for EB-5 Visa takes around 12-14 months." They also guided the participants about the basic requirements of establishing offices in USA ■
