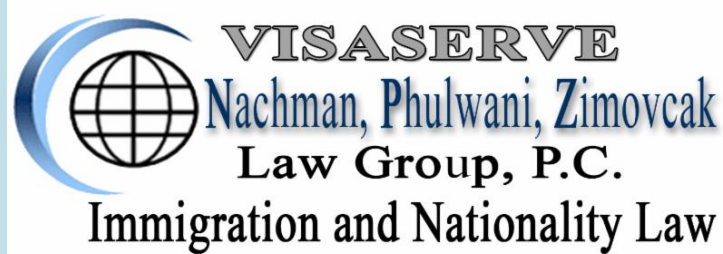

### **TRUMP ADMINISTRATION PLANS TO RESTRICT GREEN CARDS FOR THOSE ON PUBLIC ASSISTANCE: Trump Strikes At The Public Charge.**

Is it lawful for the government to prevent immigrants from receiving green cards because they need public aid?

In the latest immigration policy change, the Trump Administration has announced that immigrants who are signed-up to legally receive public benefits, such as food stamps or housing vouchers, could now be denied green cards. New rules coming from the Trump Administration are designed to limit the number of immigrants who receive or may need public assistance, as the Administration feels these immigrants are a drain to the system. ### **U.S. SUPREME COURT TO HEAR CRUCIAL IMMIGRATION CASE.**

How will the decision made in Nielsen v. Preap impact the lives of immigrants in the U.S.?

The United States Supreme Court is set to hear a high stakes immigration case that could determine whether certain classes of immigrants can be detained without a bail hearing. Nielsen v. Preap is a class action lawsuit filed by a group of immigrants in the Ninth Circuit. The Plaintiffs in Nielsen are currently or have previously been detained under 8 U.S.C. § 1226, which authorizes

### **PRESIDENT TRUMP SHOCKS MANY ANNOUNCING PLANS TO END BIRTHRIGHT CITIZENSHIP.**

President Trump said he was preparing an Executive Order that would nullify the long-accepted constitutional guarantee of birthright citizenship in the United States, his latest attention-grabbing maneuver days before midterm congressional elections as he has sought to activate his base by vowing to clamp down on immigrants and immigration.

We're the only country in the world where a person comes in and has a baby, and the baby is essentially a citizen of the United States for 85 years, with all of those benefits," Mr. Trump told Axios during an interview that was released in part on Tuesday, making a false claim. "It's ridiculous. It's ridiculous. And it has to end."

What are the requirements to receive a P-1 visa?

With temporary visas becoming scarcer for immigrants due to new caps and tightened restrictions, artists, entertainers, and athletes may apply for a P-1, P-2, or P-3 visa to secure their lawful status in the U.S. P visas are "dual intent" temporary worker visas that allow an individual to engage in certain kinds of work in the U.S. related to a unique talent or skill. For qualifying individuals, a P visa can prove effective in allowing you to pursue your dreams in America. ### **USCIS REISSUES RECEIPT NOTICES FOR EXTENSIONS OF CONDITIONAL PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS.**

On October 16th, 2018, USCIS began issuing new receipt notices for certain Forms I-751, Petition to Remove Conditions on Residence, to replace previously issued receipt notices containing inaccurate information.

In August 2018, USCIS issued receipt notices for certain pending Form I-751 petitions to extend conditional permanent resident (CPR) status from 12 months to 18 months. These receipt notices were issued to provide an additional six months of CPR status to the I-751 petitioners while they continue to wait for their petition to be adjudicated. Some of the receipt notices contained incorrect information that does not affect the extension of the CPR status.

**USCIS TO BEGIN IMPLEMENTING NEW POLICY MEMORANDUM ON NOTICES TO APPEAR.**

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will begin implementing the June 28th Updated Guidance for the Referral of Cases and Issuance of Notices to Appear (NTAs) in Cases Involving Inadmissible and Deportable Aliens Policy Memorandum (PM) on October 1st, 2018. USCIS will take an incremental approach to implement this Memorandum.

An NTA is a document that instructs an individual to appear before an Immigration Judge. This is the first step in starting removal proceedings. Starting October 1st, 2018, USCIS may issue NTAs on denied status-impacting applications, including but not limited to, Form I-485, Application to Register Permanent Residence or Adjust Status, and Form I-539, Application to Extend/Change Nonimmigrant Status.

**DOS VISA BULLETIN UPDATE: VISA BULLETIN FOR NOVEMBER 2018 - IF YOUR "PRIORITY DATE" IS CURRENT PLEASE LET US KNOW?**

In the employment-based categories, there is no movement in the first (EB-1) or third (EB-3) categories. The only movement in the employment-based, second preference (EB2) category is that the cutoff date for China advances by six weeks, to May 15th, 2015.

In the employment-based, fourth preference category (EB-4), the cutoff date for Mexico advances by one month, to November 22nd, 2016. Meanwhile, in the employment-based, fifth preference (EB-5) category, Vietnam's cutoff date moves up by a month, to February 1st, 2016. The only other change is that the EB-4 category for certain religious workers and the EB-5 category for regional center cases are no longer listed as unavailable. This is because the programs were yet again extended, this time until December 7th, 2018.

Receiving a Request-For-Evidence (RFE) during an H-1B visa petition or H-1B transfer or H-1B extension has become normal opposed to when it used to be a taboo prior to 2008 when the USCIS very rarely asked for more information. Today the RFE is more of a norm than an aberration. These days the possibility of getting an RFE is in nearly 37% of the cases and it is not really anything bad. It is only the USCIS wanting more information from the petitioner in order to make sure the petition for the Job being filed really exists and if the candidate really qualifies. Some of the various types of queries in RFEs are as follows: (1) Various H-1B worksites; and (2) Level of Professional work available for H-1B workers; and (3) Financial stability of the H-1B employer; and (4) Whether the individual seeking H-1B status maintained their nonimmigrant visa status.

At the Teaneck International Film Festival, Aligarh will be shown:

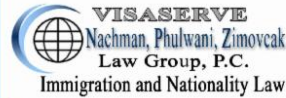
