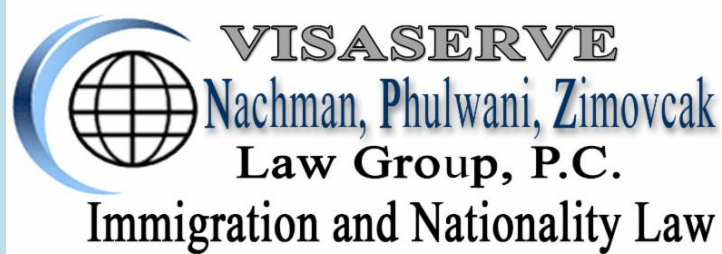

Dear Readers:

As we roll into October, our Academic Institution and H-1B and other Employer clients continue (even with the recently announced fee) to be "up in arms" about the suspension of premium processing of many H-1B visas. On October 1st, the H-1B Visas are supposed to take effect. Many folks have just not yet heard about their H-1B cases. It is anticipated that Business Immigration Lawyers will soon resort to the Federal Courts and file Writs of Mandamus. Stay tuned!

A recent announcement by the USCIS has reactivated concern about denials of applications and petitions which would result in the immediate issuance of a Notice To Appear (NTA). This new initiative is set to go into effect in early-October (after having been placed "on hold" originally) in August. We await the ripple effects ... one of which is that an already maxed-out Immigration Court will likely become even more overburdened!

The Immigration Judges' Union is in an uproar and is seeking to eliminate pressure from AG Sessions for numerical or capitation results. There is an additional initiative that aims at creating an Immigration Court that is separate from the US Department of Justice.

It is clear that an already overburdened Immigration Court system is continuing to "spiral out of control". We can only hope that these recently announced and onerous immigration law initiatives are political moves made in anticipation of the upcoming November Midterm Elections.

On a more positive note, the US Census Bureau released new data from its American Community Survey (ACS), which contains a wealth of information about the characteristics of the U.S. population. Recent ACS data illustrates the way immigrants add value to the economy through their participation in the workforce. While immigrants comprise 13.7 percent of the U.S. population, they account for an even larger portion of the labor force: 17 percent as of 2017.

Immigrants' economic contributions go far beyond their labor. Immigrants are not just workers; they are also consumers who spend their wages in U.S. businesses, thereby sustaining the jobs of other workers; taxpayers who add to the revenue stream of governments at the federal, state, and local levels; and, in many cases, entrepreneurs who directly create jobs and new businesses. Failure to recognize these facts is nothing less than "shortsighted". We commend the international entrepreneurial spirit.

USCIS TO BEGIN IMPLEMENTING NEW POLICY MEMORANDUM ON NOTICES TO APPEAR.

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will begin implementing the June 28th Updated Guidance for the Referral of Cases and Issuance of Notices to Appear (NTAs) in Cases Involving Inadmissible and Deportable Aliens Policy Memorandum (PM) on October 1st, 2018. USCIS will take an incremental approach to implement this Memo.

An NTA is a document that instructs an individual to appear before an Immigration Judge. This is the first step in starting removal proceedings. Starting October 1st, 2018, USCIS may issue NTAs on denied status-impacting applications, including but not limited to, Form I-485, Application to Register Permanent Residence or Adjust Status, and Form I-539, Application to Extend/Change Nonimmigrant Status.

DOS NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE 2020 DIVERSITY IMMIGRANT VISA PROGRAM.

The Department of State (DOS) annually administers the statutorily-mandated Diversity Immigrant Visa Program. Section 203(c) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) provides for a class of immigrants known as "diversity immigrants," from countries with historically low rates of immigration to the United States. For fiscal year 2020, 50,000 diversity visas (DVs) will be available. There is no cost to register for the DV Program. Applicants who are selected in the lottery ("selectees") must meet simple, but strict, eligibility requirements to qualify for a diversity visa. The DOS determines selectees through a randomized computer drawing. Diversity visa numbers are distributed among six geographic regions, and no single country may receive more than seven percent of the available DVs in any one year.

Can Immigration Officials Detain Parents Or Children On School Property?

The world watched as several high profile immigration arrests were made on or near school grounds during the 2017 - 2018 school year. In Houston, a 19-year-old student without legal status was detained by immigration following an altercation with another student who provoked the attack. In New Jersey, two Indonesian nationals were arrested as they dropped their children off at school. These arrests were made in violation of the traditional "sensitive locations" policy, which held that federal immigration agencies would avoid so-called sensitive locations like schools, hospitals, and places of worship. With the new school year now upon us, immigrant children are fearful of what may come.

TIMES OF INDIA: H-1B VISA HOLDERS GET A TEMPORARY RESPITE FROM NEW US REMOVAL/DEPORTATION POLICY.

In a relief for the Indian expat community in the US, H-1B visa holders are not covered, for the time being, by the deportation norms coming into force from October 1st. The leeway also applies to L-1 visa holders on intra-company transfers. The new policy of the US Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) enables officials to start deportation/removal proceedings against individuals whose applications for visa extension or change in status (say, from tourist to student) have been denied and who are not in a period of authorized stay at the time of the denial.

The USCIS is taking an incremental approach to implement its updated Notice to Appear (NTA) policy, announced on June 28th. Serving of an NTA is the first stage in deportation proceedings.

DOS VISA BULLETIN UPDATE: VISA BULLETIN FOR OCTOBER 2018 - IF YOUR "PRIORITY DATE" IS CURRENT PLEASE LET US KNOW?

Employment-Based, First Preference (EB-1) Category:

The DF cutoff dates for EB-1 India and EB-1 China are both set at October 1st, 2017, which is more than a year ahead of their corresponding dates in the FA chart. For all other countries of chargeability, the EB-1 DF date is June 1st, 2018.

Employment-Based, Second Preference (EB-2) Category:

For EB-2 India, the date of May 22nd, 2009 in the DF chart is almost three months ahead of the FA chart cutoff date. EB-2 China's DF date is also more favorable, with a June 15th, 2015 cutoff date.

Employment-Based, Third Preference (EB-3) Category:

EB-3 India's cutoff date in the DF chart is October 1st, 2009. This date is actually more favorable than the EB-2 India cutoff date in the DF chart. For EB-3 China, the DF cutoff date is August 8th, 2015.
